## Making sure Elton John is 'Still Standing' on his 40th Anniversary Tour

As part of his 2012 UK tour celebrating the 40th anniversary of Rocket Man, Elton John was playing 5 outdoor shows including Taunton and Falkirk. NoNonsense provided the 55m x 21m stages including PA wing and video supports.

Two systems were required to meet the tour schedule. Four of the five locations had never hosted a concert of this size before, including Blackpool where the stage was built on the new Blackpool Headland site, home of the Comedy Carpet by Blackpool Tower. It was a concert first for Falkirk Football Club and it was a pleasure to work with the enthusiastic team at this great sporting venue. It was a wet summer but the crowds came in their thousands and enjoyed hits including Rocket Man, Benny and the Jets and I'm Still Standing.
